7.00 <u>LAG MEETING 1ST SEPTEMBER, 2011 - UPDATE</u>:

Councillor Harvey reported that this meeting was very well attended by the local community. However, the police were not in attendance. The next meeting is scheduled for November when several key issues will be discussed.

The Committee noted that Nottinghamshire Police have reported a fourteen per cent reduction in overall crime across the county (June, 2010, to June, 2011.

On the Bingham page of the Nottinghamshire Police website, members also noted that the local neighbourhood beat team reported that anti-social behaviour is not significant. However, the local page also reported that a number of roads in the western area of Bingham had been affected by anti-social behaviour issues, including Brewster's Close, Carnarvon Place, Harvest Close and Harebell Gardens.

The Clerk was requested to write to Inspector Hallam, firstly to congratulate the local team on its contribution towards the reduction in crime levels overall and also to clarify the situation with anti-social behaviour in Bingham, particularly in Bingham West Ward and if there are any issues which can be considered or addressed in partnership with local authorities and the Rushcliffe Community Safety Partnership.
