6.00 FLOODING/DRAINAGE ISSUES:

There was a brief discussion about recent flooding issues experienced in Bingham. County Councillor Suthers confirmed that since the 1st April, 2012, the County Council had a dedicated 'Flood Unit' to address such issues. Unfortunately, legislation did not cover ensuring that riparian owners cleared the ditches. Following a report from the Chairman, the Committee agreed that the various agencies involved in flooding and drainage issues be brought together to try to address the various problems encountered. The agencies concerned included Rushcliffe Borough Council, Nottinghamshire County Council, Metropolitan Housing, Trent Valley Drainage Board and Network Rail.

7.00 LENGTHSMAN SCHEME:

The Chairman presented notes from the meeting held on the 27th July, 2012, (attached). County Councillor Suthers confirmed that the County Council's trial scheme was underway and being monitored. Bingham Town Councillors agreed to await results of the pilot scheme before making any formal recommendations.

8.00 THE MANOR HOUSE - UPDATE:

The Chairman confirmed a meeting had been arranged to be held on the 5th September, 2012, for all interested parties.

9.00 TRANSPORTATION CONSULTATION:

Nottinghamshire Council is running a consultation which closes on the 14th September, 2012; the Clerk to obtain hard copies of the questionnaire. Regarding Service 24, there will be no changes to this service before January, 2013.

10.00 STATION STREET TOILETS:

Rushcliffe Borough Council has confirmed that the Station Street toilets are to be closed with immediate effect due to their condition.

01 St. Mary's/Grove Roads

02 Market Place

Nottinghamshire County Council had confirmed that the felled tree in the Market Place had been monitored over a two year period as it was diseased and had been deemed necessary to remove it.
