
01 Saxondale Footbridge

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. That a new Car Park Working Group be formed as a task and finish group with the outline aims of:-
 - (a) Taking the recommendations in the report previously confirmed by Council on 3rd March, 2015, (Folios 7792 7799 refers) and breaking these down into a series of workable actions and outcomes on which the Council can start work directly or consulting as appropriate.

 - (c) Taking into consideration such other matters relating to car-parking in Bingham as it may consider appropriate, including investigations into alternative means of travel, and

- 2. The detailed terms of reference for the Group to be discussed at its first meeting and ratified by the next Environment Committee.
- 3. The Group shall be chaired by the Vice-Chair of the Environment Committee. Members shall consist of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Chair of Environment Committee and all Environment Committee members, plus open to all Councillors. Officers from Nottinghamshire County Council, Rushcliffe Borough Council, Network Rail, the Highways Agency and such other bodies as may be appropriate to be invited to participate as required.
- 4. The Group shall meet as and when required, and shall be quorate when two or more Councillors are present.
- 5. The Minutes of the Group shall be reported to the Environment Committee.
