6.00 NCC Energy and cost saving in relation to street-lighting. To consider implications and any feedback on the scheme now in operation:

The Chairman confirmed a petition was to be presented to the January Full Council meeting. The review period ended mid December, however it would be late January when the review would take place. There was a brief discussion in relation to the viability of every alternate light being left on, and use of low energy lighting across the board. It was agreed that a formal letter should be sent to Notts County Council requesting consideration of these suggestions. Also agreed Councillors would undertake walking the area in the hours of darkness to experience the impact of reduced street-lighting.

7.00 To consider request for dog waste bins:

There was a brief discussion regarding requests for siting of dog bins and it was agreed to include provision in the budget for one bin at a site yet to be determined in East Bingham.
