01 Butt Field

(a) <u>Request Re. Solar Panels at Butt Field Pavilion</u>

The Town Council had received a copy of an e-mail sent from B.F.S.C. to Norman Jowett at Rushcliffe Borough Council. A further e-mail was received by the office and some Town Councillors on Thursday evening, 22nd July, 2010, requesting a letter of support regarding B.F.S.C. installing solar panels on the Sports Pavilion at Butt Field. Whilst Councillors supported the idea, due to the fact that not all Recreational & Cemetery Committee members had received the documentation, members felt that the subject could not be discussed fully at the meeting.

The Mayor made reference to the lease, which stipulates that before going ahead with such projects, Bingham Town Council's permission should be sought first. The Clerk to send a letter to B.F.S.C. Chairman pointing this out to the Sports Club.

The matter is to be referred to Policy & Resources Committee, providing a formal letter from B.F.S.C. had been received requesting permission. Members expressed their support for environmental projects in line with the Town Council's environmental policy.
