UPGRADE TO RAILWAY BRIDGE AT BINGHAM STATION

Network Rail Representatives attended the Environment Committee meeting to discuss the foot crossings over the railway line and the amendments to the plans re the upgrade to the railway bridge. In the eventuality that the proposed supermarket north of the railway line does not materialise additional funding of £700k will have to be found before the upgrade can go ahead.

LINEAR WALK LITTER/DOG BINS

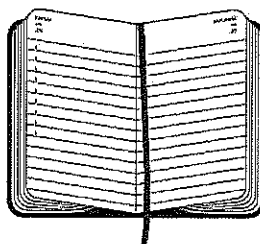

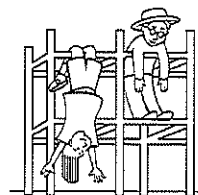
