


BINGHAM TOWN COUNCIL RULES & REGULATIONS With effect from 1st April 2014



The Cemetery was opened in 1888 and appears to have been laid out following principles established by Joseph Paxton, head gardener at Chatsworth House. He believed that cemeteries could double as arboreta, and the trees in the arboretum have been labelled accordingly. There are also a number of Commonwealth War Grave Commission headstones. A Roman Well discovered during works for the A46 has been reconstructed adjacent to the main drive as you enter the Cemetery.
