PLAY PARKS UPDATE

The work to refurbish the play park at Carnarvon Playing Fields has been awarded to Proludic, who are a Nottinghamshire based company. You may have seen their stall at the Christmas Fair. The play equipment is being manufactured and a series of meetings will take place as part of the preparations before the transformation commences.

The tender returns for the refurbishment of the Wychwood Road play park have been received. A joint evaluation meeting of representatives from the Town Council and the Bingham Community Parks Project is planned to identify a preferred supplier. At the time of writing a date had not as yet been secured. Pupils from Carnarvon Primary School will also be assisting the Town Council, they will be taking a look at a short list of preferred designs and voting for their favourite piece of equipment.

The Wychwood Road play park will not proceed as quickly from tender award to refurbishment as grant funding needs to be secured which will hopefully allow the necessary time to also resolve a land issue.

Our play park consultant will now turn his attention to the play park at Cogley Lane.
