Main Objects of Association, Club, etc:... Rushcliffe Voluntary Transport scheme provides safe, affordable transport to meet the needs of people who experience difficulty in using /accessing transport: due to age, disability, ill health, poor mobility, cognitive or mental ill health or lack of suitable transport services. Our volunteer drivers have been helping vulnerable people in the Bingham area and across Rushcliffe to get out and about for over 30 years. They use their own cars to provide a 'door to door' service to passengers. Alleviating loneliness and isolation and improving wellbeing is embedded in our day-to-day activities. This ranges from simply getting users to where they need to be – be it medical appointments, shopping, or recreational activities – to going above and beyond to care for and support passengers on their trips, and to provide a safe and friendly service.

Our passengers give us feedback on a weekly basis regarding how we make a difference to their wellbeing..."Makes me feel safe knowing it's a reliable driver" - "Excellent service, office staff and drivers very helpful and caring" - "Without this service I would be housebound, it is really comforting to know that you are there"
