



The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bingham Remembrance Day Parade) (Temporary Prohibitions) Special Event Order 2019 (R19-160)

Name of Relevant Event: - Bingham Remembrance Day Parade Event.

Name and address of the promoter of the event: - Pete Kennedy, 21 Skylark Close, Bingham, Nottingham, NG13 8QH.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and by virtue of The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008, as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at **Bingham** in the **Borough of Rushcliffe**: -

- (1) Vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding in the following length of roads from **10.25 hours until 10.40 and 11.50 until 12.05 hours**:-
 - a) **Newgate Street**, between its junctions with Green Lane and Market Street
 - b) **Market Street**, between its junctions with Newgate Street and Moor Lane
 - c) **Market Place**, for its entire length
 - d) **Church Street**, between its junctions with Market Place and Cherry Street
 - e) **Cherry Street**, between its junctions with Long Acre and Church Street
- (2) Vehicles are prohibited from waiting, loading and unloading in the following length of roads from **08.00 hours until 12.30 hours**:-
 - a) **Newgate Street**, between its junctions with Green Lane and Market Street
 - b) **Market Street**, between its junctions with Newgate Street and Moor Lane
 - c) **Market Place**, for its entire length
 - d) **Church Street**, between its junctions with Market Place and Cherry Street
 - e) **Cherry Street**, between its junctions with Long Acre and Church Street
- (3) Any existing restrictions or prohibitions previously introduced by an order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 will be temporarily suspended for so long as this notice is in force and traffic signs are in place.
- (4) Vehicles displaying the relevant permits issued by Rushcliffe Borough Council shall be exempt.
- (5) The Order will not have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates, or to any premises only accessible to pedestrians from such a road.
- (6) It is intended that the Order will come into force from **on Sunday 10th November 2019**.

The prohibition is required for the purpose of:

- Facilitating the holding of the event.
- Enabling members of the public to watch the event.
