Application for Capital Grant Aid
Bomberz Skateboarding CIC

Main objects of Association The practice and promotion of the sport of skateboarding in Bingham, initially by the provision of a skatepark for the use of all residents, students and those working in Bingham. To further develop the sport by means of events, training and promotional activities which will focus on the health benefits (both physical and mental), the inter-generational and non-discriminatory aspects of the sport, and opportunities for the development of other skills such as mentoring, street art, photography and site management.

Purposes for which finance is sought Funding is requested for initial outlay, including

- registration as a Community Interest Company (CIC), £35,
- registration of the name Bomberz, including trademark searches £400
- Land Registry searches for proposed site of the skatepark £40
- Publicity £300 (includes posters, flyers, promotional items)

Additionally the organisation Skate Nottingham has offered to hold an open event at Bingham Leisure Centre in May 2020, towards which Bomberz will need to make a financial contribution. Details of the event can be supplied on request. The estimated cost for this is £400, to cover hire of the venue, Skate Nottingham's team time and promotion of the event. Other costs will be met via Skate Nottingham's LIS grant.

We plan to promote the project to the community using professionally prepared display materials which could be used at the Farmers' Market, Bingham Fair and other events. Cost of display panels will be £150-200, a banner sign £30 and a roller banner £30. Hire of a stall for the Fair would be £30. Professional assistance with artwork may be required, costs for this to be determined.

Total amount requested £1,465.00

Further information The skatepark project has the support of the Police and Crime Commissioner, the local community police, the Community Play Parks Group, several Town Councillors and many local residents of all ages who signed a petition in support in 2019.
