Firstly thank you for your support in allowing Tables & Benches to be stored for Community & Business use in the Council Yard.

The objective of BCE using the Market Square in August on Fridays and Saturdays is to help local businesses and give the public a safe environment to socialise in.

We aim to have a pop up bar and 3 local street food vendors. People will need to book a table online, food can be delivered from any food establishment in Bingham and it is also our intention to have some low key entertainment if government rules allow.

Bingham Community Events are not in a position to absorb the cost of this event as we have lost significant potential revenue due to cancelled events, however we can with the support and financial assistance of BTC.

Covid Humanitarian Fund if applicable could help support this event and in turn support some retail jobs and businesses, whilst giving the community some much needed fun. It's estimated that to run this event it will cost approx £2600. It would be for 4 weekends in August and hopefully give a much needed boost to all.
