 discretion if a request to speak is made and then a vote taken by Councillors, to
 suspend standing orders (Council's rules) and allow comments. Please could we ask you to
 mute your microphones on entering the meeting.
- Recording The meeting will be recorded, when the recording is on, this should be shown
 on your screen. The recording may show faces of those with the camera turned on and this
 will be uploaded to the website. By having your camera on, you will therefore need to be
 aware that you are agreeing to this. If you do not wish your face to be seen, please leave
