NHS & KEY WORKERS EVENT (around 5th July)

8pm – Clap for the heroes and ringing of church bells.

The organisers are hoping the government will announce this day as a Public Holiday but in my opinion this is unlikely. Without a Public holiday some of the items above would be difficult.

Total Cost: £1,915

BEER FESTIVAL (September tbc)

To encompass local businesses.

Total Cost: £3000

CHRISTMAS MARKET (26th November)

Similar format to previous one.

Full allocated budget of £4,000
