About Our Groups and Sessions:

Adult Learning - Work Readiness: Courses to help support your confidence and work readiness. Contact the Children's Centre for more information about the courses on offer.

B.A.B.E.S Breastfeeding Group: Meet other breastfeeding and pregnant women, you can also receive support from a trained Breastfeeding Peer Supporter.

Forest School: A specialised outdoor programme that may include: den building, creating fairy gardens, treasure hunts, exploring the outdoor environment, using tools to make jewellery, bug houses etc and more.

Little Talkers: These sessions are for 4 weeks and designed for children aged between 2 - 3 years to share ideas and strategies to support development in speech, language and communication.


New Parents Group: This is a 6 week course for new parents. The group will offer you ideas around supporting your child's wellbeing and new ideas for play, as well as an opportunity to meet other new mums.

Now I am 2: This targeted intervention is for parents/carers and the children aged 18 months up to the age of 3. The focus of the programme is to promote learning through play and also independence.
