Information/history about your group	We are the sixth oldest club in the UK and have been providing cricket in Bingham for over 225 years. we now have a full womens and girls section to add to our strong men and boys squads and this year will have 4 Saturday teams for the first time!

(costing's/quotes to be included)	We are looking for a grant to help us with the increase in training equipment we are having to purchase to cope with the additional numbers of women and girl players and additional junior players we are gaining organically. This includes soft balls and hard balls for indoor and outdoor training. The cost is £902.20 and we are looking for a grant of 66% (£600) to help us to afford this increase. The rest will be funded by a fund raising event held in March.		
Is the group making a financial contribution or providing evidence of any fundraising	yes, we will be providing 33% (one third) raised at a fund raising event in March, we are also raising money twowards a net bay project that the council is aware of at the moment.

This equipment will benefit ALL 161 of our members in some way as the balls will be used by all but they will predominantly be used by our womens and girls section.
