NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENACE WORKS A52 Saxondale

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential safety improvement works to the A52 Southbound and Northbound from Saxondale Roundabout to New Lane Road.

During our scheme of work, we will:

- refresh road markings, road studs and traffic loops
- install central hatching.
- install High Friction Surfacing between junctions.
- install a vehicle activated sign on the approach Tithby road junction.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start 8th January 2024 and is scheduled for completion by the 14th February 2024.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses, and road users, we will work under full carriageway closures **Monday** to **Friday 8pm** to **6am**. We will try to work in phases to try and lessen disruption by only closing the section we are working on.

Some elements of the work will require full weekend road closures from **8pm Friday** to **6am Monday**. This will be confirmed nearer the time giving more precise timescales.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We will make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
