



Bingham Town Council – Councillor Vacancy

Following a resignation, a vacancy for a Councillor in the South East Ward is available for co-option.

Bingham Town Council owns and manages various sites within the Town, including the Cemetery, five play areas and Linear Park nature reserve. The council also provides support to local community organisations and promotes Bingham's sense of place through its grant aid scheme, events, floral displays, and Christmas lighting displays.

Bingham Town Council is very active and has many strategic priorities that they would like to deliver for the Town. This includes progressing the re-development of the Wynhill site to provide improved and increased community facilities, securing an area of land for community use off Chapel Lane, improvements to Linear Park and refurbishment of the Old Court House. The Council is also continuing its work with other key stakeholders on the parking provision in the Town and the potential for a 3G facility.
